**Entry qualification, rules & regulations.**

1. Little Miss Tonopah , Tonopah Princess, Princess & Junior Queen must be grades K through 12<sup>th</sup>. (To participate you must be registered in school. Sorry no exceptions.)
2. Contestants must submit a \$10.00 entry fee with their entry form. The contestants may pay the fee with Cash, Check or Money Order payable to TDC / Jim Butler Days.
3. Contestants must be available on Tuesday starting at 4:30 PM for practice and will stay until after the competition starting at 6 PM. (Girls can be dropped off for practice, if needed.)
4. Music and/or any other special equipment **MUST** be given to Dawn at least the day prior so we can make arrangements if needed. **NO GLITTER** or anything else that will cause an extreme amount of cleaning.
5. You and your child must have good sportsmanship even if your daughter isn't chosen.
6. Once chosen, the three princesses must be available the week of May 26<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>, 2017 to be present at a few of the functions and to be introduced.
7. All girls are encouraged to participate in the building of the float & should ride on the float on Saturday. (I will be out of town this year for the parade so I am looking for a volunteer to head off the float.)
8. All entries must be paid for and given to Dawn on or before the deadline on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 5 PM.
